## SCHEME OF EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF JUNIOR HINDI TRANSLATOR AT AIIMS, NEW DELHI

This is in reference to Recruitment Notice No.1-6/2015 Estt (RCT) published in the newspaper on dated-01.11.2018 uploaded on the Institute website on 3-11-2018 and its subsequent corrigendum/s uploaded on the website for the post of Junior Hindi Translator at AIIMS, New Delhi. The Scheme of Recruitment Examination including important dates for the post of Junior Hindi Translator for AIIMS New Delhi are as under:-

#### OVERVIEW OF SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The Examination and Evaluation will be in two stages:

- 1. Online CBT mode Examination (Stage-I):- Online (CBT) mode Examination with minimum qualifying marks for eligibility to appear in the Stage-II Examination
- 2. Written Test (Stage-II): Only those candidates who will possess minimum qualifying marks in Online (CBT) mode Examination (Stage-I) will be called for Written Test (Stage-II)

#### **Online CBT mode Examination (Stage-I)**

1.1 Nature of Examination:

This will be an Online (CBT) mode examination for appearing in Written Examination (Stage-II)

- 1.2 Language and Mode of Examination: The Language of Examination will be Hindi & English.
- **1.3 Duration of Examination:** Three Hours (180 Minutes)
- 1.4 Number of questions and Marks Distribution: 200 MCQs of 200 marks with four alternatives for each question (180 MCOs related to subject, 20 MCQs related to Aptitude / General Knowledge / Awareness). Each MCQ shall carry one mark for every correct answer. There is a Negative marking of 1/3 for each incorrect / wrong answer.
- 1.5 Qualifying Marks for Online (CBT) mode Examination (Stage-I): The candidate will have to score minimum 50% for General, 45% for OBC and 40% for SC to qualify in the Online (CBT) mode Examination (Stage-I) to be eligible to appear in the Written Examination (Stage-II). \*
- **1.6 Syllabus of Examination:** The syllabus will be in accordance with education qualification and experience as mentioned in the advertisement.

- 2. Written Test (Stage-II)\*: Only for those who qualify in Stage-I
  - 2.1 Nature of Examination:

This will be a Written Test Examination.

- 2.2 Language and Mode of Written Examination: Written test will be in both Hindi and English language.
- **2.3 Duration of Examination:** 1½ hours (90 minutes)
- 2.4 Description of Examination and Marks for Written Test: The Written test will be of 100 marks and distribution of marks will be as follows:

2.4.1. Hindi to English Translation: 15 marks

2.4.2. English to Hindi Translation: 15 marks

2.4.3. Letter Writing (Hindi): 10 marks

2.4.4. Letter Writing (English): 10 marks

2.4.5. Essay Writing (Hindi)(200 words): 20 marks

2.4.6.Essay Writing (English)(200 words):20 marks

2.4.7Medical Terminology English to Hindi: 5 marks

2.4.8. Medical Terminology Hindi to English: 5 marks

## 2.5 Qualifying Marks for Written Test (Stage-II):

The candidate will have to score minimum 50% for General, 45% for OBC and 40% for SC in Written Test (Stage-II).

2.6 The date of Written Test Examination (Stage-II) will be announced in the result of Online (CBT) mode Examination.

#### 3. Preparation of Merit List

3.1 A candidate has to qualify both in Online (CBT) mode Examination (Stage-I) and Written Test (Stage-II) separately. Final Merit will be prepared according to the total marks obtained by the candidate in the Online (CBT) mode Examination (Stage-I) and the Written Test Examination (Stage-II) (i.e the total marks obtained after adding the individual marks of Stage-I and Stage-II will be used to determine merit provided the candidate has qualified in each Stage separately).

#### 3.2 Tie cases (equal marks) will be resolved using:

- (i) By using date of birth with older candidates placed higher.
- (ii) If not resolved by (i), the number of wrong answers / negative marks will be used wherein those with less wrong answers / negative marks will be placed higher (in Online (CBT) mode Examination).

#### **Important Note:**

- 1. The candidates are advised to download their Admit Cards from website <a href="www.aiimsexams.org">www.aiimsexams.org</a>. Only website generated Admit Cards will be treated authentic and permissible to appear in the said Examination. No Admit card will be sent by Speed post.
- 2. As per practice, the Online (CBT) mode Recruitment Examination of the above mentioned post will be conducted without pre-examination screening of the applications of the candidate with regard to their eligibility. Hence, the candidatate will be allowed **PROVISIONALLY** to appear in the Online (CBT) Mode Examination (Stage-I) as well as Written Test (Stage-II)
- 3. However, the original documents of all selected candidates related to fulfilment of eligibility criteria, experience etc. will be verified by the Recruitment Cell before the final appointment.
- 4. All applicants are required to visit the website regularly as all subsequent Corrigendum / Addendum / Updates will only be uploaded on the website.
