SCHEME OF EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF TUTOR IN NURSING AT AIIMS, NEW DELHI

This is in reference to advertisement dated 02.05.2018 uploaded on the Institute website on 03.05.2018 and its subsequent corrigendum/s uploaded on the website for the post of **Tutor in Nursing** at AIIMS, New Delhi. The Scheme of Recruitment Examination including important dates for the post of **Tutor in Nursing** for AIIMS New Delhi are as under:-

1.1 OVERVIEW OF SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

(i) The Examination and Evaluation will be in two stages:

Stage-1 : Online (CBT) mode Theory Examination with minimum qualifying marks for eligibility to appear in the Stage-II Examination.

(ii) **Stage-2** : Interview (the 10 times of the number of qualifying candidates against the post in each category will be called for interview)

1.2 Online (CBT) mode Theory Examination (Stage-1)

1.2.1. Nature of Examination:

This will be an eligibility examination for appearing in Stage-II (Interview) and for preparing Merit list.

1.2.2. Language and mode of Examination:

The Language of Examination will be English only.

1.3. Scheme of Examination:

1.3.1. Duration of Examination, Number of Questions and Marks Distribution:

Three Hours (180 Minutes), 200 MCQs of 200 Marks with four alternatives for each question (180 MCQs related to subject, 20 MCQs related to Aptitude/ General Knowledge / Awareness)

1.3.2. Marks for Stage-1(Theory Examination):

Each MCQ shall carry one mark for every correct answer. There is a Negative marking of 1/3 for each incorrect / wrong answer.

1.3.3. Qualifying Marks :

a) The candidate will have to score a total of 50% for General and 40% SC to qualify in the theory examination (Stage-1) to appear in Stage-II (Interview).

1.4. Syllabus of Examination:

The syllabus will be in accordance with education qualification and experience as mentioned in the advertisement.

1.5 Interview (Stage-II)

a) Interview will be of **50** marks.

b) The number of candidates to be called for the Interview (Stage-II) will be 10 times the number of posts advertised (category-wise).

c) **The dates of Interview will be announced in the result of Theory Examination (Stage-1)**

1.6 Preparation of Merit List

- a) All those candidates who qualify in Stage-1 Theory Examination and falls within 10 times the number of post in each category will be called for **Interview** (Stage- II). Final Merit will be prepared by totaling the marks obtained by the candidate individually in the Theory Examination and the Interview.
- b) **Tie cases (equal marks) will be resolved using:**
- (i) By using date of birth with older candidates placed higher.
 - (ii) Those who secure more marks in Theory Examination
 - (iii) If not resolved by (i) & (ii), the number of wrong answers / negative marks will be used wherein those with less wrong answers / negative marks will be placed higher.

Important Note:

1. The candidates are advised to download their Admit Cards from website www.aiimsexams.org. Only website generated Admit Cards will be treated authentic and permissible to appear in the said Examination. No Admit card will be sent by Speed post.
2. As per practice, the Online (CBT) mode Recruitment Examination of the above mentioned post will be conducted without pre-examination screening of the applications of the candidate with regard to their eligibility. Hence, the candidate will be allowed **PROVISIONALLY** to appear in the Online (CBT) Recruitment Examination.
3. However, the original documents of all selected candidates related to fulfilment of eligibility criteria, experience etc. will be verified by the Recruitment Cell before the Interview as well as final appointment.
4. All applicants are required to visit the website regularly as all subsequent Corrigendum /Addendum / Updates will only be uploaded on the website.
